





South Padre Island & Boca Chica Beach

South Padre Island

Just 25 miles from Brownsville is the modern beach resort of South Padre Island. This barrier reef isle offers all the contemporary conveniences including gourmet restaurants, seaside attractions, and high-rise hotels. Along with tanning, beach combing, and playing in the surf, endless white sand beaches on both the Gulf of Mexico and Laguna Madre offer plenty of activities.

Boca Chica Beach

Boca Chica is a pristine, undeveloped beach bordered by the Brazos Santiago Pass jetties to the north, and the Rio Grande mouth to the south. No paved streets, no hotels, no amenities just beautiful white sand where you can spend the day or camp overnight.

Los Fresnos

Neighboring Los Fresnos, with its city flavor

and country charm, is the center of popular attractions including the world-famous Little Graceland Museum and the annual PRCA rodeo.

Port Isabel

Standing at the entrance of the Port of Brownsville and Laguna Madre, the major landmark of this seaside town is its century and a half-old, brick lighthouse. Having guided sailors in the past, it now serves as an information center. The Lighthouse and Port Isabel Historical Museum interpret local history for visitors.

San Benito

Just north of Brownsville is San Benito with a variety of events and attractions. "Conjunto Music" is preserved through community efforts at the Narciso Martinez Cultural Arts Center, which is home to the Annual Conjunto Music Festival that takes place the second week of September.




Attractions & Things To Do

Nature & Ecotourism

Brownsville and the Rio Grande Valley have many species of the flora and fauna to share with visitors. The Gladys Porter Zoo is Brownsville's internationally famous zoological and botanical park. This intriguing zoo is a most visitor-friendly oasis and a unique haven for over 1,500 rare species of mammals, birds, reptiles, fish, and insects amidst natural settings with ever-blooming plant life and also serves as a rehabilitation center.

The Sabal Palm Audubon Sanctuary with its intact mature growth of Texas Sabal Palms is ideal for birding or a relaxing nature walk on its trails.

Resaca de la Palma State Park boasts the largest tract of native habitat in the World Birding Center network. Traveling Highway 4 east takes one out to the pristine, undeveloped Boca Chica Beach on the Gulf of Mexico through farm and ranch lands to bahias and dunes for birding, dolphin viewing, surf casting, shelling, and beach driving. Just north of Brownsville is the world famous Laguna Atascosa National Wildlife Refuge, a 45,000 acre preserve on the Laguna Madre. In the upper Rio Grande Valley is the Santa Ana National Wildlife Refuge with its extensive trail system and noted international birding reputation.

Perfect Climate for Outdoor Activities

From salt to fresh water venues, the area offers a variety of sport fishing venues from charter boats to pier to surf and offshore fishing. The sunflower fields, beginning in September, are popular with hunters wanting to bag the White-winged and Mourning Doves during our special season.

When looking for outdoor exercise, hike and bike through history on the Brownsville Historic Battlefield Trail. The Southern Pacific Linear Park where the trailhead is located offers a peaceful, beautiful setting for walking, picnics and quiet reflection.

The Brownsville Tennis Center boasts 15 fully lighted all-weather courts. Professional instruction, competitions - both amateur and sanctioned; a Tennis-ball cannon. and pro-shop complement the center's comprehensive offerings.

The Heritage Attraction

Brownsville is a city of museums and historic sites which interpret our past. Brownsville has the unique distinction of being the site of the Palo Alto Battlefield National Historic Site, which marked the start of the war between the United States and Mexico, and Palmito Hill, the site of the last battle of the Civil War. The Battle of Palo Alto in the 1840s impacted the U.S. such that it ultimately changed the shape of the country. The Visitors Center displays exhibits, and provides information to visitors at its location on FM 511 and Paredes Line Road.

The Historic Brownsville Museum is housed in the restored Southern Pacific Railroad Depot. The Brownsville Historical Association expanded the Stillman House Museum into the Brownsville Stillman House Museum into the Brownsville Heritage Complex, which gives visitors a pictorial view into the past.. The Commemorative Air Force Museum has vintage military aircraft on display and stages an annual Air Fiesta every March. A fantastic Children's Museum of Brownsville explores the local heritage through a Marketplace area where children can serve themselves a raspa or snow cone among many other exhibits at the museum. Housed right next door to the Children's Museum is the Costumes of the Americas Museum, which showcases authentic Mexican and Latin American folk costumes, some over 100 years old, in beautiful Dean Porter Park.

Great Architecture

Downtown Brownsville has a great number of historically significant buildings identified with Texas Historical Plaques and they are part of the Brownsville Heritage Trail. Tours with a heritage focus of Brownsville and Matamoros are available through local operators. Be sure to walk around Downtown Brownsville to discover a variety of architectural designs from the various periods, starting in the mid 1850s to the present time modern structures. Visitors can also tour the Old City Cemetery where the ornate crypts provide a glimpse into the past. The Old City Cemetery Center focuses on history, art and folk customs of the cemetery. Guided Tours of the cemetery are also available.

Fiestas & Special Events

The border culture comes alive with festivals and events throughout the year in Brownsville.

Charro Days, a week-long fiesta, celebrates the long-time friendship between Brownsville and its sister city, Matamoros, Mexico. Charro Days is held the last week of February and features folkloric

dancing, mariachis, food and parades. In fact, Charro Days hosts the only known international parade with numerous beautifully decorated floats. With the concurrent Sombrero Festival and Mr. Amigo Association activities, fiesta-goers have live concerts with popular and Tejano music, a Jalapeño Eating Contest, Grito Contest, Tortilla Toss, local food, dances, and loads of fun.

The CAF Air Fiesta brings vintage and military aircraft to the skies over Brownsville in March. A signature event in Brownsville is the annual Latin Jazz Festival in October, which features some of the best regional and national acts.

Performing & Fine Arts

The arts continue to expand their offerings with the help of many Brownsville organizations. The University of Texas at Brownsville and Texas Southmost College Arts & Entertainment Season is filled with opera, Latin dance, Russian ballet, stage productions and other classic performances. The UTB-TSC Patron of the Arts Series offers numerous artistic and musical presentations throughout the academic year.

The Brownsville Society for the Performing Arts brings special, world-class musical concerts to town throughout the year. One of their more popular events is the annual Guitar Ensemble Festival. The Brownsville Museum of Fine Art stages major events including two international shows in March and April. The Camille Lightner Playhouse presents an ongoing schedule of live productions, about every six weeks, with special youth theatre productions throughout the year. The Valley Symphony Orchestra and Chorale showcases their talent at a number of performances in Brownsville.



In March of 1929, Charles Lindbergh landed in Brownsville from Mexico City establishing airmail service from the U.S. to Mexico. This marked the opening of the Brownsville Municipal airport; an event also attended by Amelia Earhart.

The name was changed to the Brownsville-Pan American Municipal Airport after Pan American Airlines began service here.

In the 1930's commercial airline service was enhanced with the addition of Braniff Airways and Eastern Airlines. Captain Eddie Rickenbacker attended the opening ceremonies.

In the 1960's the airport evolved into a major industrial area

and a new weather radar system was installed.

The 1970's and 80's marked the building of a new terminal and control tower; in addition the airport was renamed Brownsville South Padre Island International Airport.

The 1990's brought us Doppler weather radar, the establishment of the Rio Grande Valley Wing of the Commemorative Air Force and new air carrier service to Houston and the world.





ust across the Rio Grande from Brownsville is a beautiful glimpse into Matamoros, Mexico. Our friendly neighbor invites visitors to add an international flavor to their visit and enjoy all Mexico has to offer.

Art and handcrafts from all parts of Mexico can be found in the shops and markets of Matamoros. The goods include the leather, silver and gold jewelry, talayera pottery, Zarapes, boots, and art. Many shops are just across the Gateway International Bridge. However, more shops are just a short taxi or tourbus ride away at the Juarez Market. Some of the shuttles have pick-up points near the Gateway International Bridge.

Matamoros offers many restaurants to suit many tastes. From traditional Mexican fare to regional seafood dishes and even great steaks, visitors are sure to be satisfied. The dining experience often takes on added dimensions with costumed servers and mariachi music.

Many sites in Matamoros take you back into a colorful past. The Casa Mata Museum is a rich, historical reminder of numerous military actions that have resulted in the abbreviation "H." to precede Matamoros, which conveys the meaning "heroic." At Plaza Hildago, visitors can discover a marvelous cathedral built in 1825 and renovated historic buildings such as the city hall and the Matamoros Casino. The "Museo del Agrarismo Mexicano" depicts the agricultural heritage of the State of Tamaulipas and Mexico with numerous exhibits and authentic artifacts from the Mexican Revolution of 1910.

Matamoros has a beach on the Gulf of Mexico known as Playa Bagdad. Thatched palapas dot the beach. Regional fishing tournaments are held year-round and camping on the sand is a tradition among the locals. The many celebrations include the Expo Fiesta in June and July, Mexican Independence in September, the Festival Internacional de Otoño in October with acts from around the globe, the Day of the Dead in November, a vast display of Christmas lights across the city, and Semana Santa at Easter. Continental Airlines provides service connections with Houston on five daily flights. At the airport, several national and regional car rental companies operate. Taxi service is readily available and shuttle services operate seasonally.

Some of the local ground tour operators provide shuttle service in the Rio Grande Valley and connections into Matamoros. The Brownsville Urban System, BUS, operates an extensive system of bus routes around the city.





rownsville weather is generally favorable for outdoor activities with at least 234 sunny days a year. The subtropical climate permits year-round gardening and cultivation of citrus and cold-sensitive plants. Brownsville rarely has severe weather. The tidal change in water elevation between cycles in the Brownsville area generally ranges from 0.1 feet to 2.7 feet.

Weather & Apparel

As the official weather data above suggests, lightweight apparel is appropriate for much of the year. Even in December and January usually just a light sweater or jacket may be needed in the evenings or early mornings. The lifestyle of the Rio Grande Valley is quite casual and relaxed attire is quite appropriate. Boots and denim to shorts and a polo shirt are very common.

Border Crossing Helpful Hints

Current Requirements to Enter the United States From Within the Western Hemisphere by Land or Sea

U.S. Citizens

A verbal declaration and the ability to prove to a CBP officer, if requested, that your claim to U.S. citizenship is valid. Because it is difficult to prove your identity and citizenship without documents, presenting a driver's license and either a birth certificate or naturalization certificate, or a passport, is highly recommended.

Lawful Permanent Residents

Alien Registration Card (Form I-551) or other valid evidence of lawful permanent residence status is required.

Canadian Citizens and Citizens of the British Overseas Territory of Bermuda

A verbal declaration and the ability to prove to a CBP officer, if requested, that your claim to Canadian/Bermudian citizenship is valid. Because it is difficult to prove your identity and citizenship without documents, presenting a driver's license and either a birth certificate or naturalization certificate, or a passport, is highly recommended.

Mexican Citizens and Nationals

All Mexican citizens, including children, are currently required to present a border crossing card or passport with visa.

Land Sea Document Requirements

Beginning January 31, 2008, U.S. and Canadian citizens 19 years and older who enter the U.S. at land and sea ports of entry from within the Western Hemisphere will need to present government issued photo ID, such as a driver's license as proof of identity, along with proof of citizenship, such as a birth certificate or naturalization certificate, or a passport. Children age 18 and under will be able to enter with proof of citizenship. Verbal claims of citizenship and identity alone will not be sufficient to establish identity and citizenship for entry into the United States. Please be sure to visit CBP.gov for updates on travel documents and details as to when new requirements will go into effect.

Know Your Destination Country Documentary Requirements

It is strongly recommended that all travelers leaving the U.S. verify the specific documentary requirements for their destination country. This information is available through travel.state.gov, or by consulting with the Embassy of the country you are visiting to determine what documents are needed to meet the entry requirements of that country. These requirements could include a birth certificate, passport, or passport and visa for entry into that country.

The Fort Brown Memorial Center, located on the campus of The University of Texas at Brownsville, offers meeting space for local businesses and to those who are visiting the area. The complex consists of four meeting rooms that are available for rent for public and private events. The Stillman Town Hall seats 120, both the Stokely Hall and the Lee Youth Center accommodate up to 180 people and the Jacob Brown Auditorium has a seating capacity for 1,500 people.

In addition, the Holiday Inn of Brownsville with 141 guest rooms provides full service hotel meeting facilities with 5,742 sq. ft. of usable space that can be divided into four separate smaller rooms to accommodate various sized groups.
